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Submission forms will be reviewed by the ELSO guidelines subcommittee monthly, discussed with the ELSO executive board, and revisions or clarification may be asked of the submitting author. Final approval to the authors will be sent via email by one of the ELSO guidelines subcommittee members.

ELSO asks that authors submit a draft of the new guideline within 6 months of board approval to begin work on the guideline. This allows for revisions, final board approval and publication within a 12 month timeframe to ensure guidelines are up to date.
